2 cups sugar

1 cup self-rising flour, sifted

3 eggs

2 1/2 cups canned milk, undiluted

1/2 tsp cinnamon

1/2 tsp nutmeg

1 tsp vanilla

1 stick margarine, melted

Heat oven to 450


What is Holy Motion?
